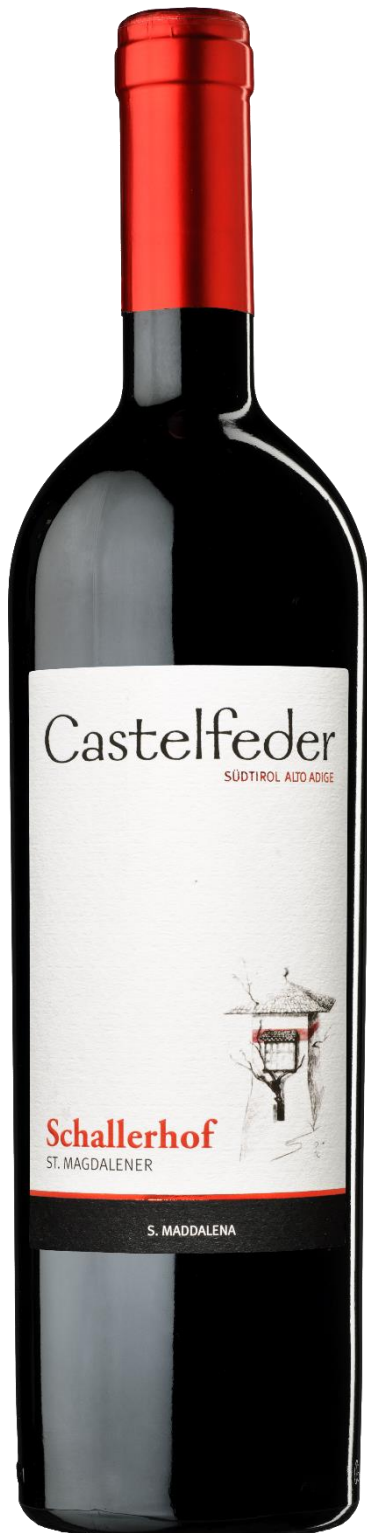


## Schallerhof St. Magdalener



Our "Schallerhof" originates from a 3 hectare area in the wine village of St. Magdalena above Bolzano, which gives its name to this wine, which is very traditional for South Tyrol. On the sunny southern slopes in the north of the South Tyrolean capital, our St. Magdalener grows on sandy, loosely weathered soil. In the middle of our vineyard is a tower built in Tibetan style by the owner, which makes the vineyard so unique.

Hand-picked, destemming, 10 - 14 days maceration with peel in stainless steel, 6 months ageing on fine lees.



The S. Maddalena is the strongest of our Schiava wines due to its small Lagrein content. Ruby red colour with slightly hints of violet. The dry, full and spicy flavour with light tones of almonds is typical for this variety. S. Maddalena is a perfect accompaniment to red meats (grilled or boiled).



Alcohol: 13 % Vol.

Acidity: 5,2 g/l

Residual sugar: 2,5 g/l
