Vernatsch is an autochthonous grape variety that is unique in South Tyrol. The berries, which are unusually big for grapes, produce this typical fruity, light and light South Tyrolean red wine. This wine grows in special individual vineyards on the slopes of Breitbach, a faction of the village of Kurtatsch in South Tyrol's Unterland.

Bright ruby-red in colour, fruit aromas as well as vinous flavours. Light and smooth tannins and a pleasant freshness, this well-balanced wine is uncomplicated and easy-drinking and a perfect combination to traditional Speck.
